## Fire Emergency Burn Ban

WHEREAS, **ROLETTE COUNTY**, North Dakota in anticipation and preparation for the 2021 Grass/Brush Wildland Fall Fire Season;

And

WHEREAS, the impact of fires could threaten the health, well-being, and safety of citizens in Rolette County;

And


WHEREAS, the cost of response and the inordinate equipment wear may be far in excess of available County Resources;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Chairman of Rolette County Board of Commissioners, in compliance with N.D.C.C. 37-17.1-10., declares a Fire Emergency Burn Ban (to include but not limited to a ban on garbage/pit burning, campfires, and burning of farm or crop land) remain in effect when the North Dakota Rangeland Fire Danger Rating is in **High, Very High, Extreme** and/or a **Red Flag Warning** has been issued for Rolette County, North Dakota from **March 23<sup>rd</sup> 01:00 hours, 2021 thru November 1<sup>st</sup> 23:59 hours, 2021**. **Exclusion to this Burn Ban Declaration would be any North Dakota Certified Fire Agencies/Departments conducting necessary Fire Mitigation Burns, having the sole responsibility for maintaining such controlled burns.** To view the Burn Ban map of North Dakota, go to the following website: This site is updated every morning.

THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THIS BURN BAN IS A CLASS B MISDEMEANOR (NDCC 37-17.1-10.1: MAXIMUM SENTENCE OF 30 DAYS IN JAIL AND A \$1,500.00 FINE).


